Charlottetown UPEI Day Camps

All of the UPEI Fun and Fitness camps will be offered in French as well as English depending on enrollment. Some of these camp activities are shared with other camps so expect 50%+ time in French. To ensure a French camp register early.

They will also offer two French Immersion Camps, August 24 and August 31st.

Camps are from June 29 to Sept 5th daily, Monday to Friday.

It offers a wide range of water activities including sailing, windsurfing, kayaking and snorkeling. *CPF pays the ferry costs for CPF registered campers.* A chaperone is provided on the ferry for the ages 8-14 groups. Transportation to the Souris ferry is the responsibility of the parents. This camp is managed by Rita Castonguay and is operated under the Quebec Camping Association Guidelines.
